3. For community members to take environmental issues in their own hands, local empowerment through education, research and data accessibility are implemented.

4. The Environmental Protection and Management Law of Liberia and other relevant laws are fully implemented bringing companies and individuals alike into full compliance thereby creating a safe environment for this and successive generations.

5. International Environmental Agreements including the Paris Agreement are fully implemented.

6. Green Revenues generations through carbon market and climate change trust funds that support national development are fully established and operational.

7. The Environmental courts that fast track environmental law violators accountable are established and operational.

8. Other cross-cutting issues including gender and children protection are fully integrated into environmental programs planning and implementations.

The Strategic Plan is not just a document -it is a call to action. The EPA's roadmap outlines clear, actionable steps to address environmental challenges and create meaningful impact.

The budget of the plan is \$32,078,000. With this the Government of Liberia will contribute \$15,188,000. We are asking our partners to provide the balance of \$16,890,000.
